Cairns Arts

The Cairns Art Gallery is part of the Arts Precinct in the city and just one block from the Esplanade. It also hosts aboriginal and international artists alike to showcase their works.

Just a short walk away, the new Cairns Performing Art Centre (*CPAC*) gives an amazing venue for theatre, music and dance performances. While opposite CPAC is the Munro Martin Parklands which hosts outdoor theatre, stage and music events.

Cultural and other Events

Our park and open spaces become home to a number of events and festivals throughout the year, many of which celebrate our multi-cultural communities and talents. The Cairns Convention Centre also hosts events from indoor rodeos, the Cairns Taipans (NBL team) home games through to conventions and exhibitions.

Perhaps one of the most famous cultural and arts events on the Cairns calendar each year is the Cairns Indigenous Arts Fair (CIAF) with live shows, art, installations and stages for introducing the

public to indigenous cultural from not only Cairns and Far North region but also from our neighbours in Papua New Guinea and the Pacific Islands.

The Papua New Guinea Independence Day celebrations take place across the city in September each year, marked with dance, song and art.

Music plays a huge role in our city – from the street buskers, cafes and nightclubs to the more formal theatre events.

Festivals and music events are promoted across the region from the city to the outback – each one with its own

distinct beat and rhythm.

Shopping in Cairns is world class – from the malls to the markets. Each weekend you will find a local market somewhere in the region including the popular 'Rusty's Market' in the city.
